Bridging Fundamentals Policies

Reserving your student's space in the class is on a first-come-first-serve basis and is determined by when the online enrollment form and registration fee is received. All of our classes do have maximum student limits so please register as soon as possible.

Tuition and Fees Agreement: After submitting this form and the \$50.00 Registration Fee (non-refundable), your child will be officially enrolled in his/her class. This can be paid by money order or a certified check and mailed to the following address: 425 Zachary Way, Garner, NC 27529. If you prefer to pay by credit or debit card, I will send you an invoice through Paypal so you can pay online. The Registration fee is due by July 20, 2017. Other payments and due dates are as follows: A payment of \$155 is due no later than August 15, 2017. A payment of \$155 is due no later than October 31, 2017. A payment of \$150 is due no later than February 1, 2018. After receipt of a payment, the payment is non-refundable. If payment is delinquent more than 30 days, your child will not be permitted to attend classes until all delinquent tuition has been paid in full.

Class Schedule: Class will begin the second week of September of 2017 and end the last week of May. Each class will meet for 45 minutes twice a week for 34 weeks. While there are no make-up classes, if a student misses a class I am available to help the student via phone or email to assist him/her with questions he/she may have as a result of the missed class, and every class is recorded so he will have access to the recorded class. (There is an exception to make-up classes, which is described below in the Class Cancellation section.)

Tests and Homework: Parents are responsible for grading and administering tests to their own child/children outside of class time. Homework will be given from the textbook, but will not be graded by the instructor. Each student and his/her parents are responsible for checking the student's homework. However, during the class there will be time allotted to discuss homework problems.

Class Maximum: Our online classes are limited to 20 students. Once the class maximum has been met, you will be notified that there is a wait list. If you are placed on the wait list, there may be someone who drops the class (which will make room for you). We may offer the same class at a different day/time to accommodate the waiting list.

Course Cancellation: Bridging Fundamentals reserves the right to cancel any course for any reason before the course begins. If a course is canceled before the course begins, all pre-paid tuition and registration fees paid will be returned.

Class Cancellation: In the event of an emergency, the instructor reserves the right to cancel a class. If a class is cancelled by the instructor, a make-up class will be scheduled.
